A Pivotal moment for AIDS: June 2011 High-Level Meeting UN Member States commit to new targets for 2015



Halve sexual transmission of HIV



Halve HIV transmission among people who use drugs



Ensure no children are born with HIV



Get 15 million people on ART



Reduce TB deaths in people living with HIV by 50%



Close the global resource gap for AIDS and increase
funding to US\$ 22-24 billion per year

A Pivotal moment for AIDS: continued also committed to critical enablers



- Remove obstacles such as laws and policies to provide affordable and effective HIV prevention and treatment products

Eliminate gender inequalities and gender-based violence;

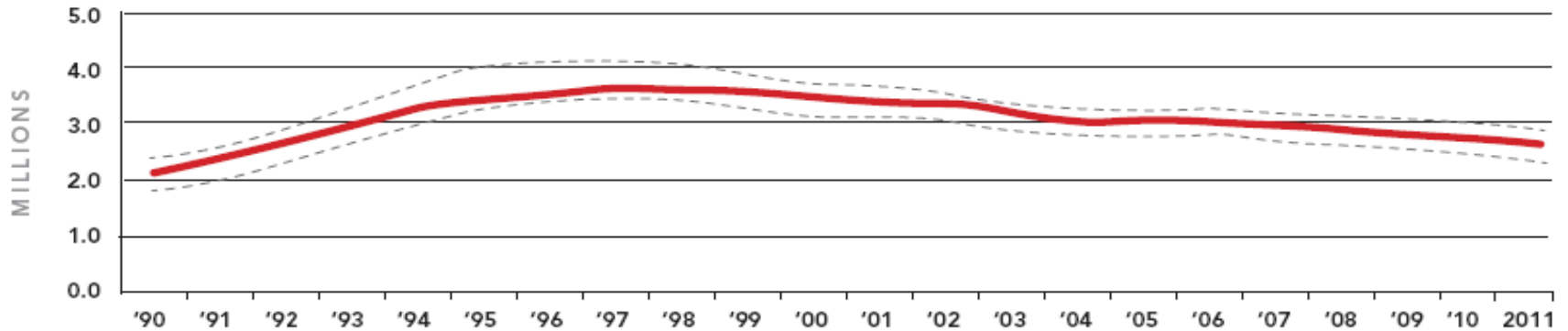


Eliminate remaining HIV-related restrictions on entry, stay and residence;

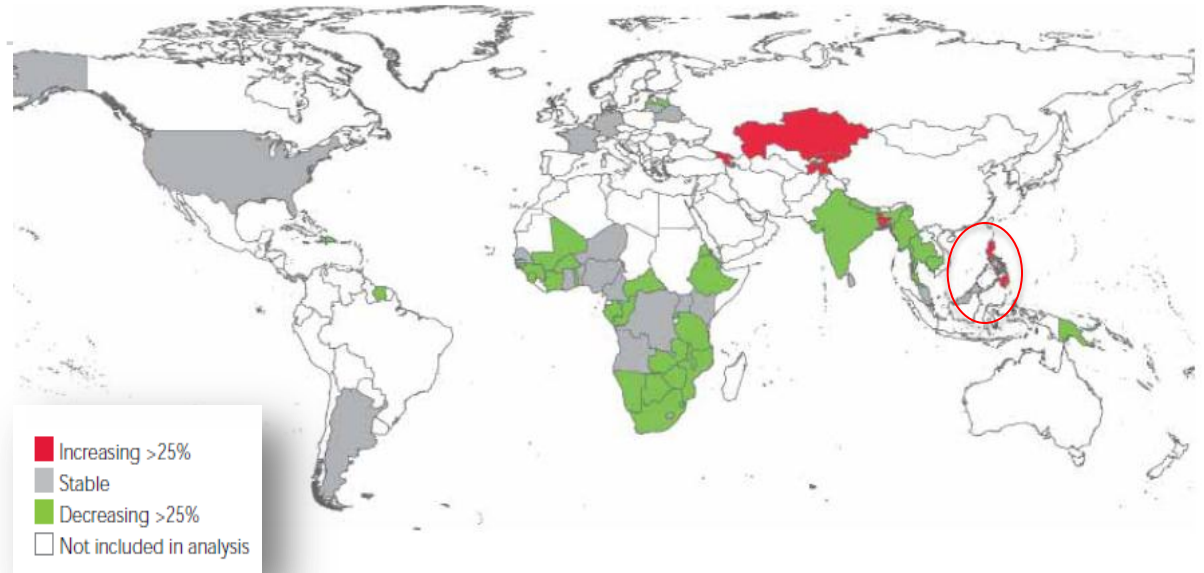

GLOBAL 2011 – new infections declining



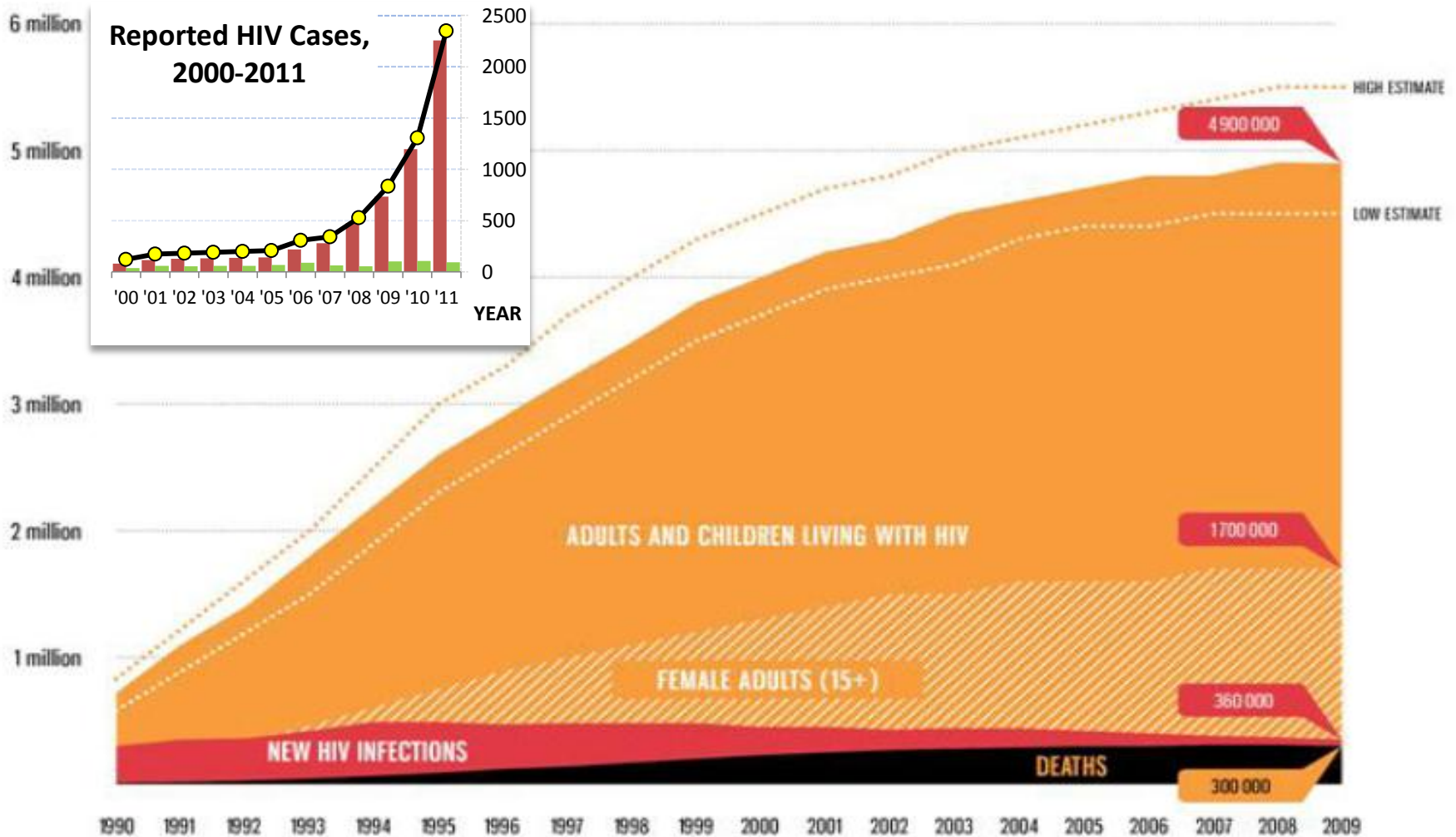
Number of people living with HIV
 Total – 34.2 million
 Adults – 30.7 million
 Women – 16.7 million
 Children (>15yrs) - 3.4 million

People newly infected with HIV
 Total – 2.5 million
 Adults – 2.2 million
 Children (>15yrs) - 330,000

Asia Pacific – new infections stabilizing

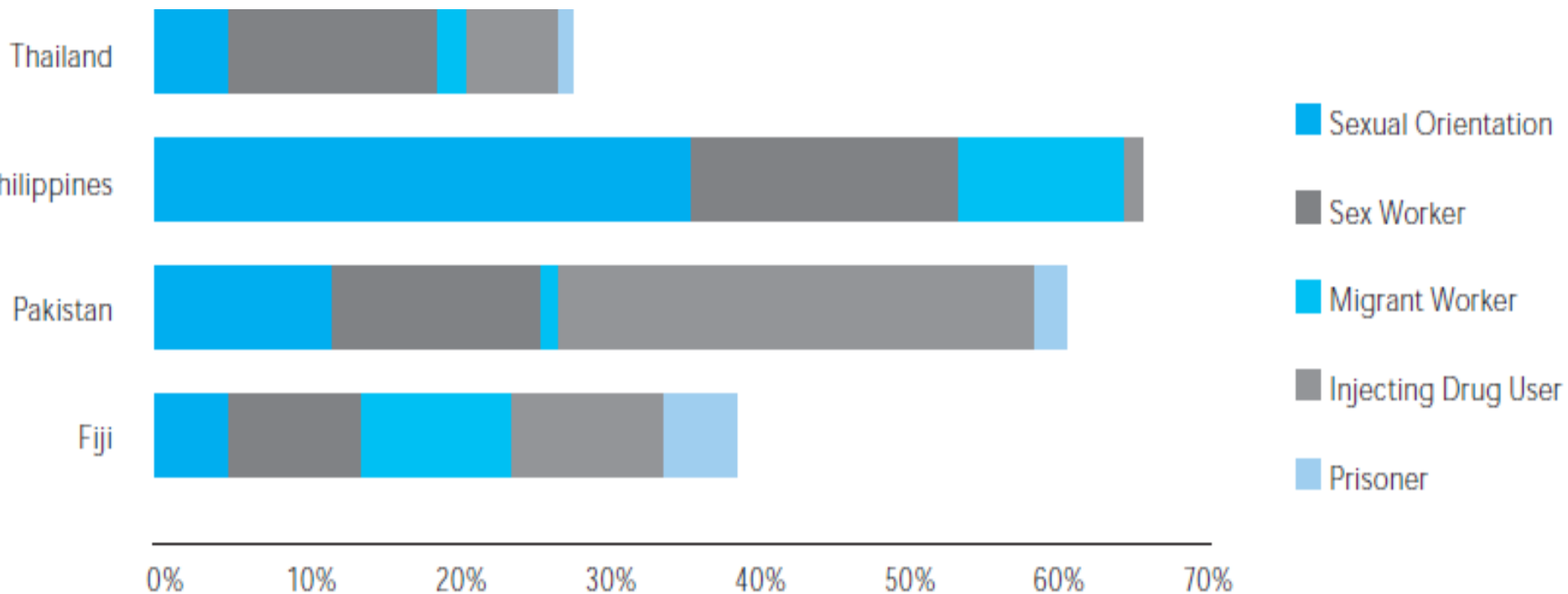

Reasons for Stigma & Discrimination – other than “HIV”



For Filipinos Living with HIV

- 21% - verbal insult, harassed, threatened
- 38% - loss job or refused employment
- 8% - denied health care
- 8% - physical assault

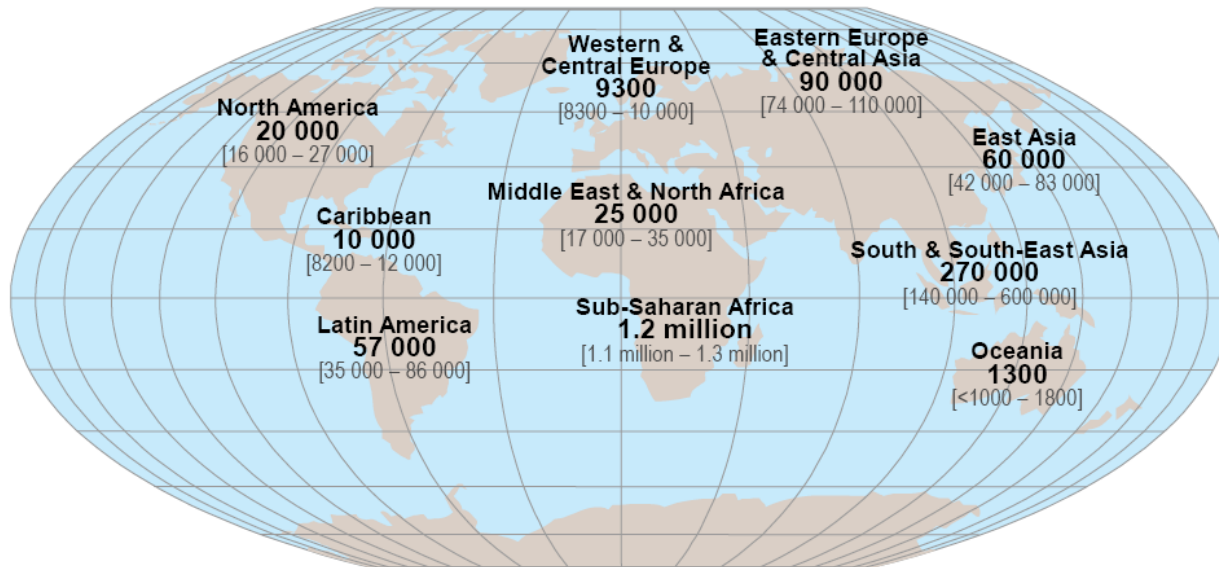
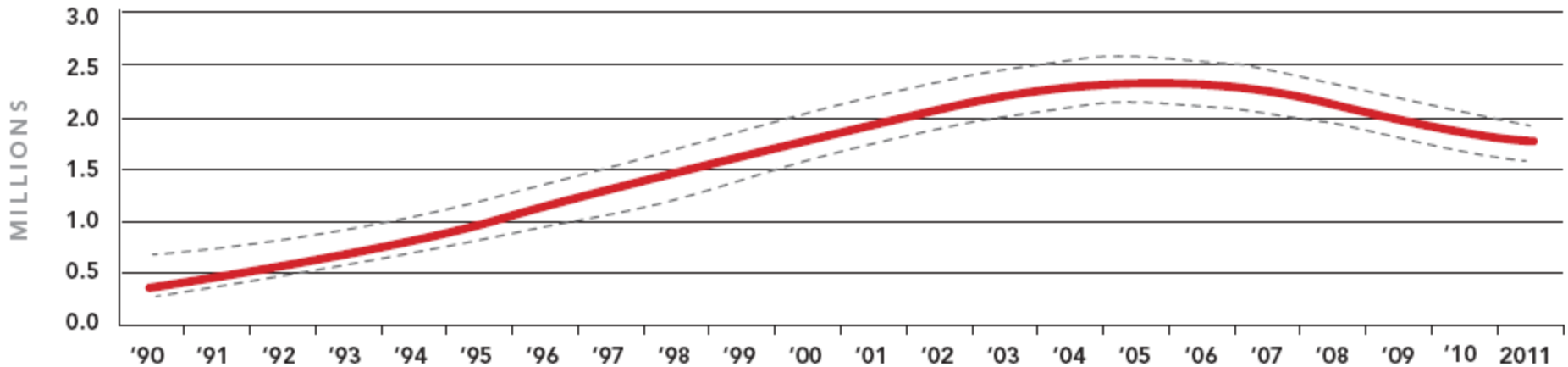

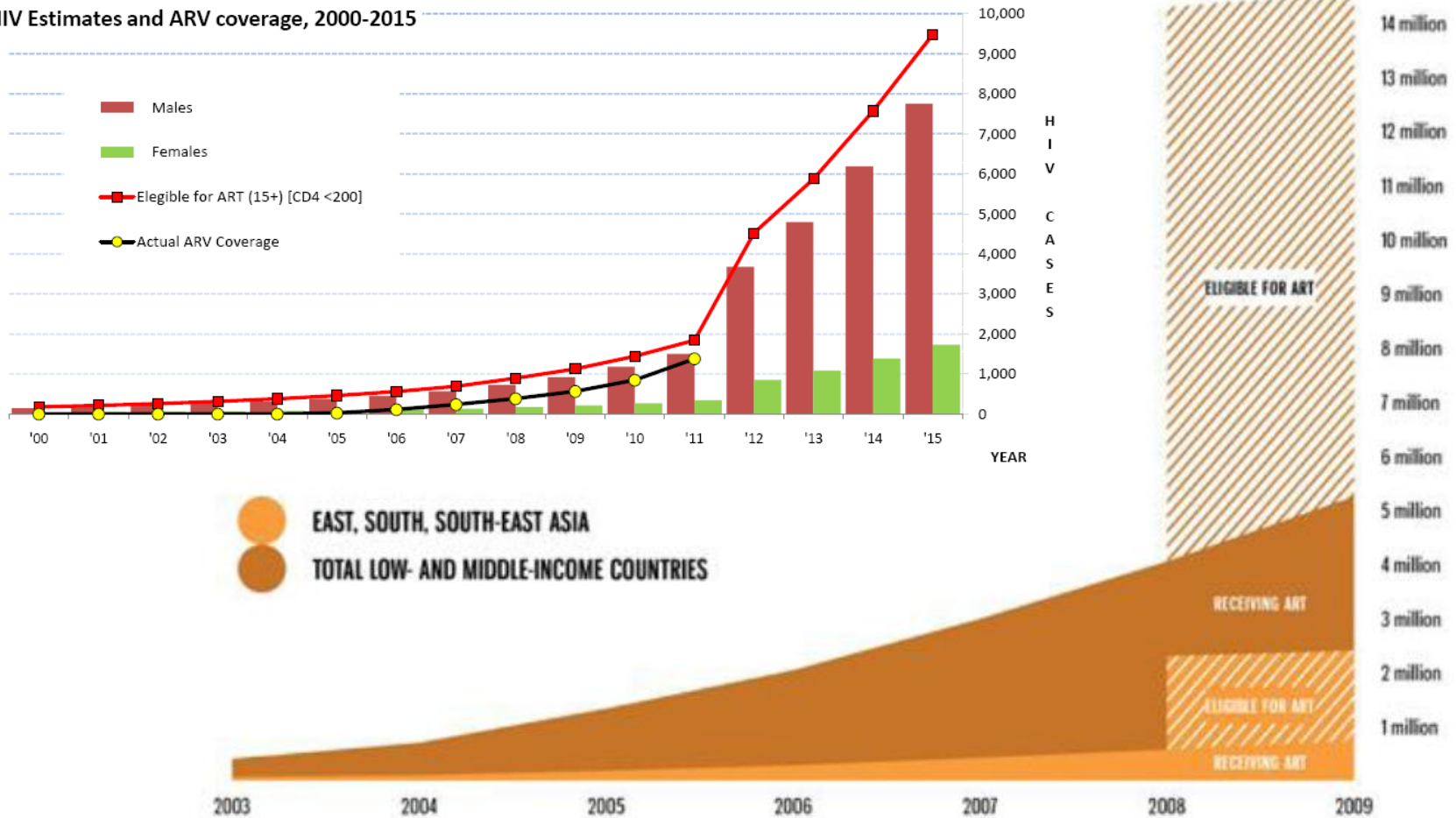
In Philippines:

- 17 deaths reported in 2011 compared to 2 in 2010
- Estimated 550 – 1,000
